Things to do to Prepare for the Event!

Patrol Equipment List

- **PATROL FLAG**
- 2 8ft. and 1 6ft. staves (2-3 in. in diameter)
- Wool blanket
- 100 ft lashing cord
- Fire Ring

Scout Equipment List:

- Camping Gear
- Scout Essentials
- Water

Stations will include elements of the 1910 Merit Badges that are being resurrected for this year only. Scouts may want to brush up on Morse Code, Semaphore, First Aid, and Map and Compass Skills in preparation for the Camporee. (Did we mention knots and lashings?)

Cooking: Scouts will need a meal plan and food for the weekend. We would ask that they look to make all meals a 1910 meal. The Saturday Night meal will be a judged meal. The criteria for the judging will be:

- Taste
- Authenticity of meal (was it a meal that was eaten in 1910)
- Authenticity of ingredients (were the ingredient all readily available in 1910)
- Authenticity of cooking tools and utensils (Were the tools and utensils used in 1910)
- Presentation

Units can have fires on Friday Night and cooking fires on Saturday night, they must be contained in a unit provided Fire Ring.

Saturday Night Campfire: Units should prepare skits and songs for the Campfire – give preference to any 1910 or early scouting songs and skits.
